Complete class attendance for students and submit. 'Daily Review' activity following the TAPPLE approach. Provide a visible lesson structure with clear lesson objective/s Use of 'Low Key Skills' to manage student behaviour. <p>Conclusion of lesson:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Provide a summary of the key learning points. Make connections to the stated lesson objective/'s. Give specific instructions regarding homework to be completed. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Maintain regular communication with all of your child's teachers to ensure consistency in expectations. Regularly monitor your child's CONNECT.
End of the lesson	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Updating and organising their diary as directed. Follow teacher's instructions to pack away and wait for directions to leave. Ensure your workspace is neat and tidy. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Directs students to pack up. Directs students to leave at the end of the period. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Work with your child to prioritise homework and assist with this if required. Maintain regular communication with your child's teachers in regards to homework and classwork.
Moving out of the classroom	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Push their chairs in. Make an orderly exit from the class. Thank the teacher for the lesson. 	<p>Wait for the siren at the end of the period</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure classroom is left neat and tidy. Thank students and praise appropriate behaviour. Ensure classroom is locked after use and all equipment is stored away. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Support the use of good manners and appropriate language.
Moving between classes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Display positive behaviours as you move between classes in an orderly manner. Fill water bottles and use amenities. Arrive at the next class on time. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Move between classes in a timely manner. Arrive at the next class on time. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provide your child with a reusable water bottle and snack food to ensure to avoid wasting time between classes. Ensure all communication is done directly via the college and not through your child as per the Department of Educations Mobile Phone in Schools policy.
